1. PSTA Trolley – Service south of the Don Cesar

Brad Miller, Chief Executive Officer, and Heather Sobush, Planning Director, provided ridership statistics for the Central Avenue Trolley based on an on-board survey and reviewed service and vehicle alternatives for the Pass-a-Grille community.

It was the consensus of the Commission to request daily ridership numbers by the time of day and additional information on smaller busses and reduced frequency of routes in the Pass-a-Grille area, particularly during the road construction.

2. Past, Present and Future of Waterborne Transportation - Corey Hubbard of Tampa Bay Ferry

Corey Hubbard, fourth generation ferry boat operator, reviewed the history of Tampa Bay Ferry & Taxi service through Hubbard's Marina and the potential future of water transportation. Ms. Hubbard noted subsidies would be necessary through the City and community businesses.

The Commission commented on the conceptual support and noted additional discussions would be necessary to gather further information.

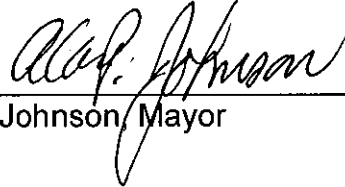
3. Adjournment
