Ordinance No. 2020-24 - Amendments to the LDC Defining, Regulating, and Adding Review Criteria For Outdoor Eating and Drinking Areas** Due to the effects of the novel coronavirus, the City has permitted citywide temporary outdoor seating to allow restaurants and bars to continue operating since March 2020. City Staff have found the reaction from both the business and residential community to be positive, with no complaints about the operation of these outdoor seating areas. Under this Ordinance, Staff are proposing that outdoor dining be permitted on private property in almost all commercial districts of the city as a permitted use, provided that no permanent or temporary amplified equipment for outdoor music is provided. Operation of permanent outdoor seating in the right-of-way, or provisions for outdoor music or rooftop dining or drinking, are proposed in most cases to remain subject to City Commission approval. Staff are further proposing additional regulations for outdoor music, and amending definitions as required.
