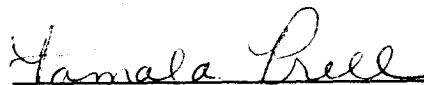

Items for Discussion

Beach Re-nourishment

Andy Squires from Pinellas County gave a brief overview of the beach re-nourishment project. From August 4th to October 20th, all three beaches (Sunshine, Sunset, Upham) were completed.

T-groin Repair

Mr. Squire advised the Committee that today he had a notice to proceed with the contractor to begin the project. Because of the lead in time, they need to actually get the geo-tubes constructed; it will probably be two or three weeks before they will be on the beach. They are trying to speed that up. The northern portion of the beach will be done first, called T-1, T-2, T-3, T-4 & T-5; they go from north to south. The contract runs from today through March 19th; they hope to be done by March 19th. The name of the company is Gator Dredging.

Having a quorum present, a motion was made that the October 27, 2009 and May 4, 2010 Minutes be approved. The motion was seconded and the Minutes, as corrected, were unanimously approved.

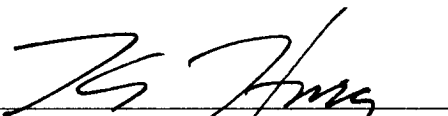
Schedule Next Meeting
