AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXT OF THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT RELATED TO GRANDFATHERING OF NONCONFORMING USES, BEACH ACCESS, COASTAL DEVELOPMENT CONTROL AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY BOARDS; ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXT OF THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP ELEMENT RELATING TO COASTAL DEVELOPMENT CONTROL AND DESIGN CRITERIA FOR DEVELOPMENT; ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXT OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE ELEMENT RELATED TO IMPACT FEE ASSESSMENTS AND IMPERVIOUS SURFACE LIMITATIONS; ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP SERIES TO CLARIFY THE DELINEATION OF THE PRESERVATION LAND USE DESIGNATION CONSISTENT WITH ADOPTED PLAN TEXT; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT HERewith, TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
