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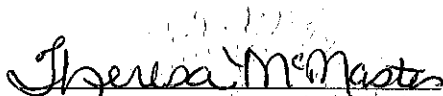
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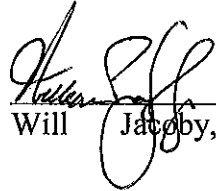
It was agreed that a Joint Meeting of the Planning Board and the Historic Preservation Board will be held on February 8, 2010, at 7:00 pm.
