SUMMER CAMP UPDATE

Mandy Edmunds reported that they are half way through the program. 156 registered children in the Camp Program and on average about 120 every week in attendance.

SKATE BOARD PARK UPDATE

Steve Hallock reported that after the recent Skate Park event, his staff said they have never seen it cleaner. He is not aware of any issues they have had since the newspaper article came out. Staff installed a camera and it is monitored 24/7 and recorded in the police dispatch.

CITY ORDINANCE

Mandy Edmunds formed a Stakeholders Group who is working on how they can make the Community Center more viable and the pool hours.

Mr. Hallock and Ms. Smith gave an overview of the New Fee Ordinance.

Chairman Johnson said that the majority of the feedback she has received is that the pool should be open more hours.

Gregory Premier made a motion that they adopt the new pool hours, as presented. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by voice roll call vote.

Steve Hallock then brought up Marketing. Their budget is only \$10,000, the same as last year.

A motion was made that the promotional budget be increased for the Recreation facilities to \$25,000. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved by voice roll call vote.

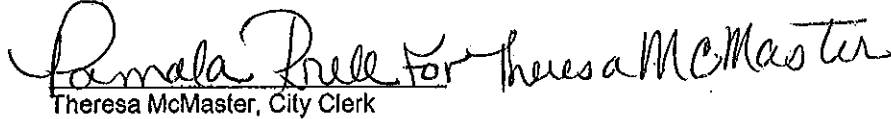
