PUBLIC HEARING**

The Board of Adjustment for the City of St. Pete Beach, Florida, will hold its regular meeting on **Wednesday, September 24, 2008, at 2:00 p.m.**, in the City Commission Chambers located at 155 Corey Avenue, St. Pete Beach, Florida to discuss the following:

Case 20080017: Frank and Maria Kavaliauskas , Owners. Request a variance to Section 6.15 requirement of a maximum 4.0 high fence with the waterfront yard to permit the increase of the fence height to 6.0'. 337 – 64th Avenue (continued from August meeting)

Case 20080019: Advance Marine Construction Agent for Donald Sweigart, Owner. Request a variance from Section 6.23(d)(3) requirement of 37.5' from waterfront property line to increase the distance of the dock to 85.0' from the waterfront property line. 2901 E. Vina Del Mar Blvd

All interested parties will be heard. The foregoing hearings may be continued to another meeting. If a person decides to appeal any decision made at this hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based (F.S. 286.0105). The City does not furnish verbatim transcripts. Interested parties should make the necessary arrangements for verbatim transcripts.
