Existing Roadway and Sidewalk

Overview

Infrastructure Improvements

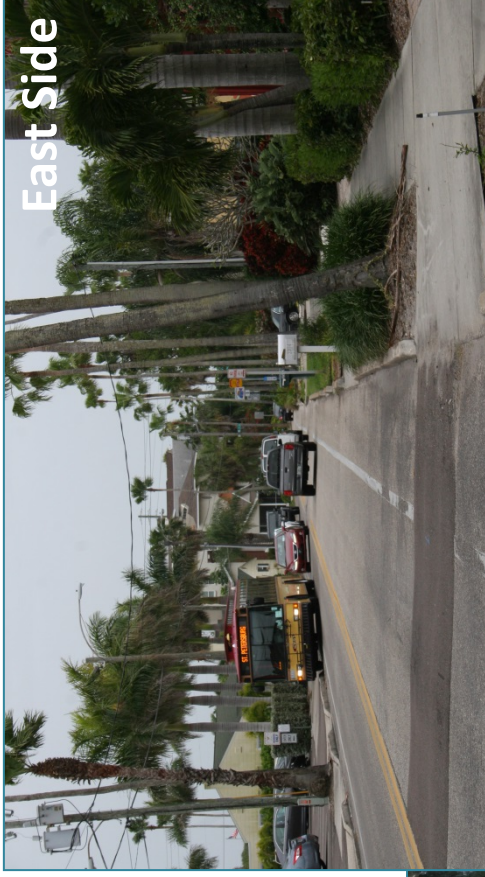
- 4,300 LF (0.8 miles)
- 15 Intersections
- Replace Gravity Sewer Line & Manholes
- Construct 8-inch Potable Water Line
- Construct 24-inch Stormwater Line, Inlets & Tide Control Structures



Tree Preservation

Preservation, Relocation, and Revegetation

- Preserve Washingtonia Palm Trees on east and west side of Pass-a-Grille Way, if possible
- Remove Australian Pines



Sidewalks & Bike Lanes

Pass-a-Grille Way will Continue to be a Multi-modal Thoroughfare

- **Current Configuration**
 - 12 ft. travel lanes
 - 2 ft. bike lanes both sides
 - 1-ft curb
 - 5 ft. sidewalk W. side
 - 60 ft. right-of-way
 - 28 ft. pavement width
- **Options**
 - Bike lanes both sides
 - Sidewalks both sides
 - One sidewalk, one bike lane

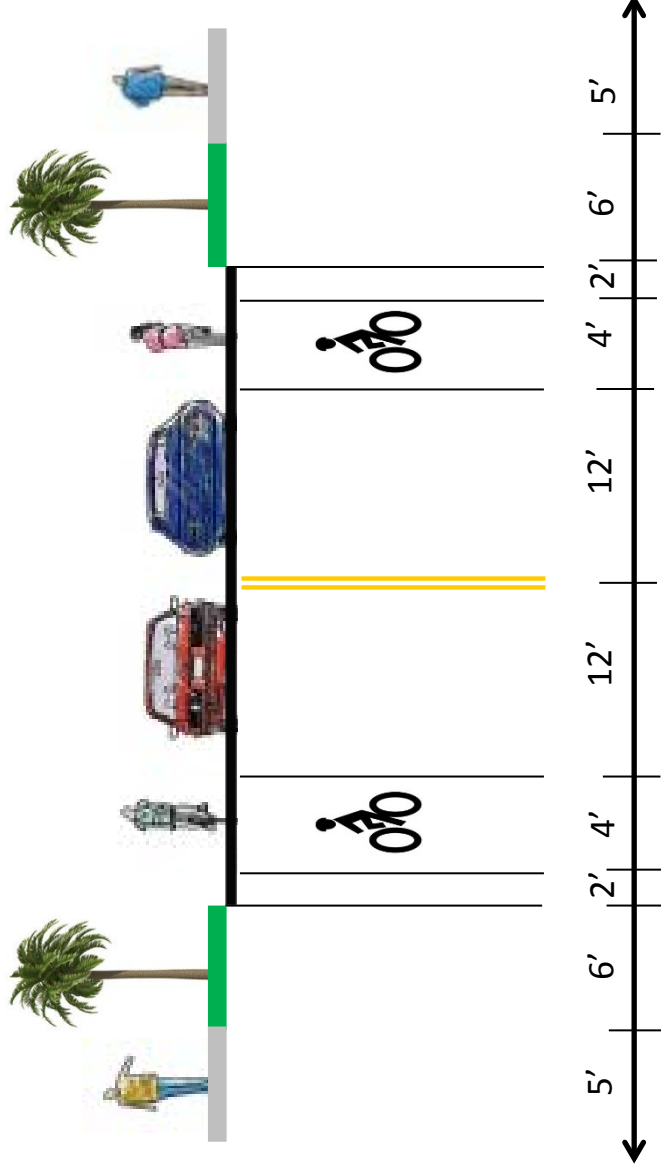


Pass-a-Grille Way

Full Alternative Cross Section

Full Reconstruction

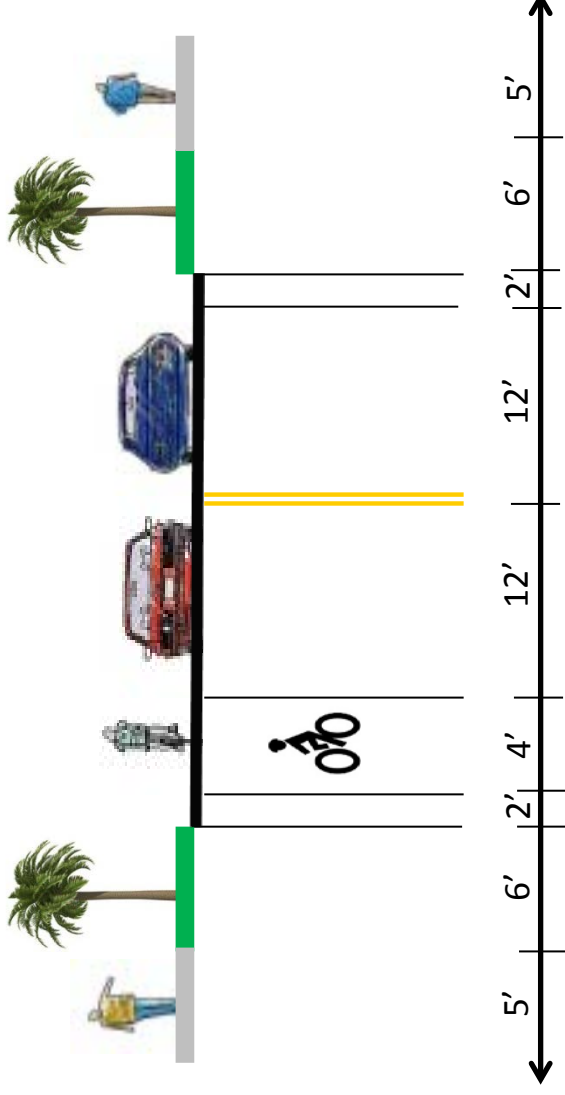
- 60 feet existing right-of-way and 28 feet existing pavement width
- Alternative is within existing ROW, but expands pavement width by 6'



Roadway Only Cross Section

Limited Reconstruction

- Tree preservation on east side
- Pavement restriped to remove north-bound bike lane
- New sidewalk added to east side
- Current sidewalk on west side remains in place



Intersection of 21st Ave. & Pass-a-Grille Way

Intersection Reconstructed to Increase Aesthetics

- Alternatives:
 - Keep existing traffic signal
 - Replace with pole-mounted decorative signal
 - Replace with 4-way stop signs
- Add brick accents at corners
- Relocate aerial electric lines at intersection underground

Construction Phasing

Target Start Date 2015; Anticipated to Last 14 Months

- **Potential Phasing Plan**
 1. S. of 30th to Cabrillo
 2. N. of 28th to S. of 30th
 3. N. of 21st to N. of 28th
 4. S. of 19th to N. of 21st
- **Considerations**
 - Day vs. night time construction
 - Maintenance of business access
 - Homeowner access for roadway and baffle box construction

Construction Costs

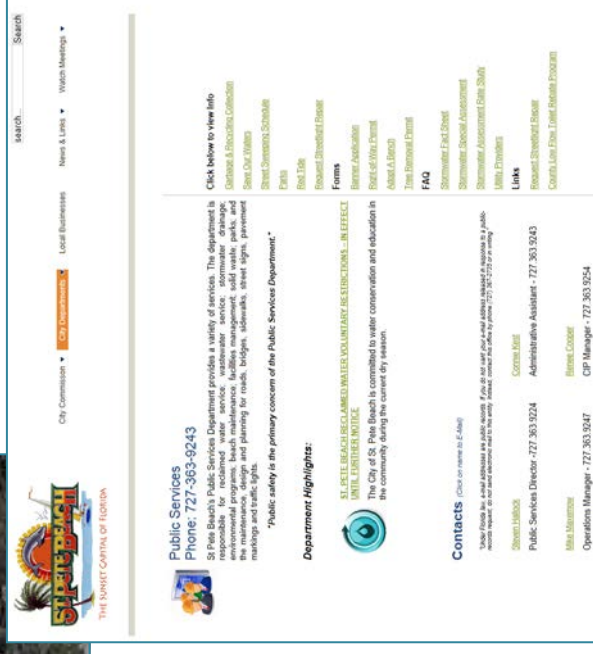
Roadway	\$2,300,013

Pass-A-Grille Way Cabrillo Avenue to 19th Avenue

- Preliminary Engineering Study Completed December 2013
- Preliminary SWFWMD COOP Grant funding approved April 2014, final approval September 2014, agreements signed October 2014
- Public Meeting Conducted April 2, 2014
 - Collecting Survey Forms
- Design completed by December 2014 in grant application
- Project Construction start 2015
