Re: Pass-A-Grille Way Public Workshop Plan Discussion and Update

Introduction

The Mayor and Commission requested an opportunity to have a public workshop to discuss the progress and provide input on the engineering plans under development for Pass-A-Grille Way.

The purpose of the workshop is several fold:

- I. To provide an update of the 60% plans and where the project is at
- II. Discuss the direction that CPWG and City Staff have been given to this point in the project
- III. What the design team needs to move forward from 60% to 90% plans

The Design Team and City Staff is seeking the public's input and the Mayor and Commissions input and direction on the topics in the attached agenda.

The objective of the workshop is not to decide on specific courses of action, but to provide the Mayor and Commission and interested parties the opportunity to discuss in a community forum the potential design options and provide input on the various options.

The information gathered at the workshop will be reviewed and presented to the Mayor and Commission at a later date to obtain specific direction to move forward towards the final design.

Topics for discussion

- Roadway and Bike Lane Widths
 - 9-ft wide car lane and 4-ft wide bike lane with 2-ft curb and gutter
 - 10-ft wide car lane and 3-ft wide bike lane with 2-ft curb and gutter
- 21 Avenue signalized intersection
 - Decorative or high definition cross walk
 - Decorative center of intersection artwork (pavers, stamped asphalt, colored concrete, etc.)
 - Keep existing black traffic signal poles
 - Replace existing traffic signal poles with decorative poles
 - Traffic detection for signal (pavement wire detection or camera detection)
- Sidewalks
 - Concrete
 - Colored Concrete
 - Stamped Concrete
 - Pavers/Bricks/hexagons
- Crosswalks other than 21st Avenue
 - Two white stripes along the walking path
 - 12-inch wide stripes spaced at 36-inch centers perpendicular to the walking path
 - Pavers/Brick/Stamp Asphalt or other decorative crossing marker
- Washingtonia Palm
 - Spacing of Trees (same throughout or change space near intersections)
 - Only Palms and Bahia sod to be installed in landscape area between back of curb and edge of sidewalk
 - Should irrigation be installed
 - Can Residents replant between back of curb and edge of sidewalk or add landscaping stones after construction at the resident expense.
- Street ends
 - Duke switch gear and transformers primary location
 - The baffle boxes will be installed here. They are underground. The concrete top (4-ft x 8-ft) and two manhole tops will be visible
- Signage
 - (Stop signs, road name signs, speed limit signs, no parking signs, etc.)

- o Keep the existing signs (remove and bring back)
 - o Install new signs (standard FDOT signs maybe larger than the existing signs)
 - o Install new decorative signs
- Driveways and Bus Stops
 - o Concrete driveways from edge of pavement (are paver/brick driveway to be replaced with concrete driveway)
 - o Locations and amenities
- Utility Undergrounding
 - o Transform Locations (potentially easements)
 - o Switch gear locations (potentially easements)
 - o Change service connections at each house (digging/boring from ROW to meter box at house)
 - o Should additional conduit be installed for future needs (fiber, etc.)
- TECO Gas
 - o Existing on west side of PAGW from Maritana to 22nd Ave
 - o Existing on east side of PAGW between 13th to 14th
 - o Service connections under road?
- Lighting
 - o 31st to 29th has brown concrete pole with Sanibel fixture
 - o Martiana to 29th and 31st to 18th has cobra light fixtures attached to utility poles
