Issue Considered: Authorize the City Manager to incorporate design elements into the Pass-A-Grille Way design engineering plans.

Summary of Issue: The purpose of the Special Meeting is to provide a project update and make some final decisions on design elements:

- Project Update for City Commission.
- Roadway Element – Staff is recommending 10 foot drive lanes, 3 foot bike lanes, 2 foot curbs, 3-5 foot green space depending on available right-of-way, and 5 foot sidewalks abutting the right-of-way line when feasible.
- Sidewalk Element – Staff is recommending standard concrete sidewalks.
- Street crosswalks – Staff is recommending standard crosswalks.
- 21st Ave intersection crosswalks – Staff is recommending a paver frame using historic brick with a concrete center with square pattern.
- Street lamp fixtures – Staff is recommending a Clermont HPS (with LED bulb) that matches the ones the Historic Preservation Board selected.
- Street lamp poles – Staff is recommending tan concrete Sanibel pole that matches the ones the Historic Preservation Board selected.
- Street Ends – These will need to be addressed on a case-by-case basis, but Staff is recommending the overall goal be to incorporate shell and landscaping as much as possible for the aesthetics and drainage while ensuring abutting property owner and public access needs are met.
- Tree plan – An Arborist is being hired to evaluate tree health and we are working with residents to save as many Washingtonias as possible. This includes transplanting existing healthy trees and replacing others with new ones.

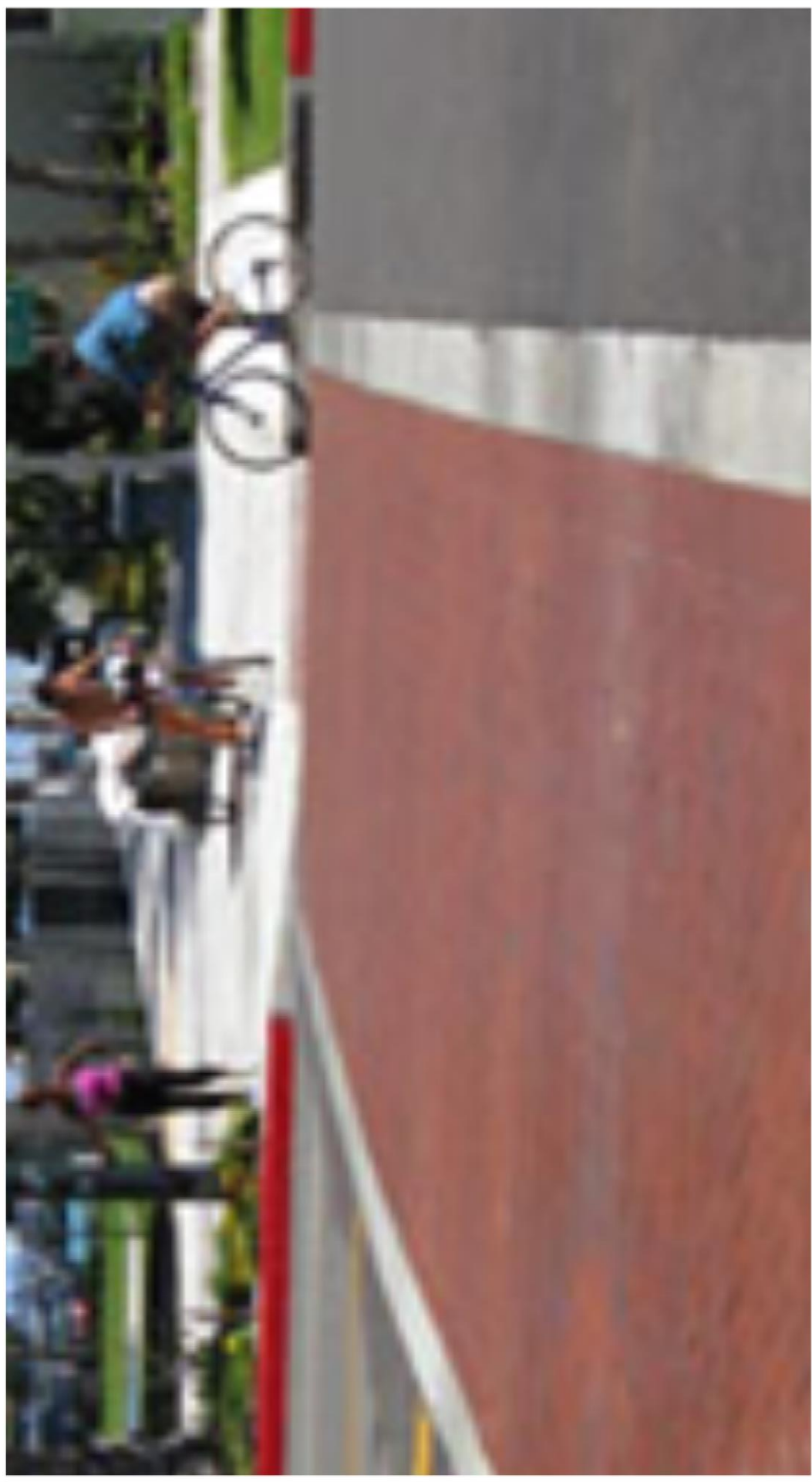
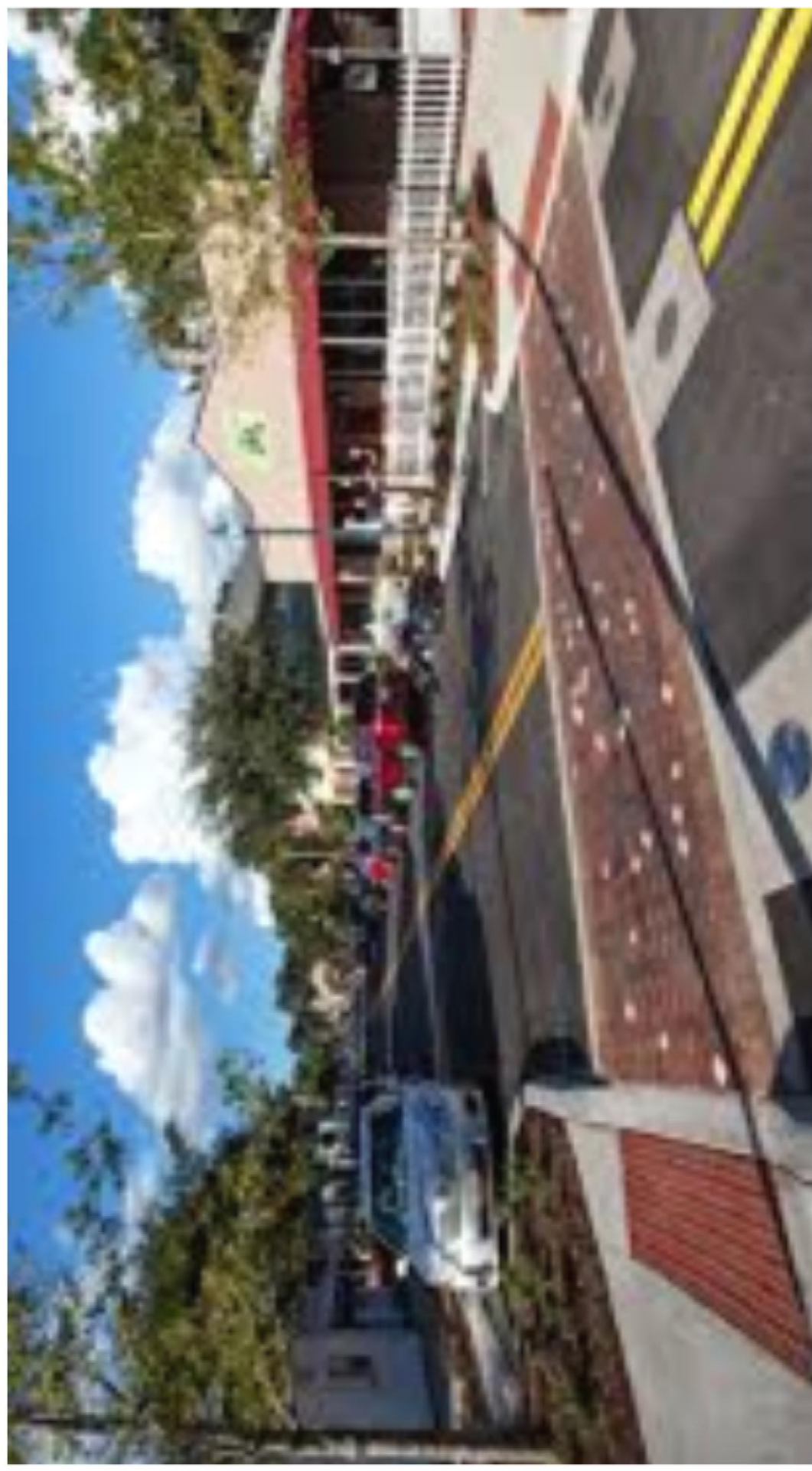

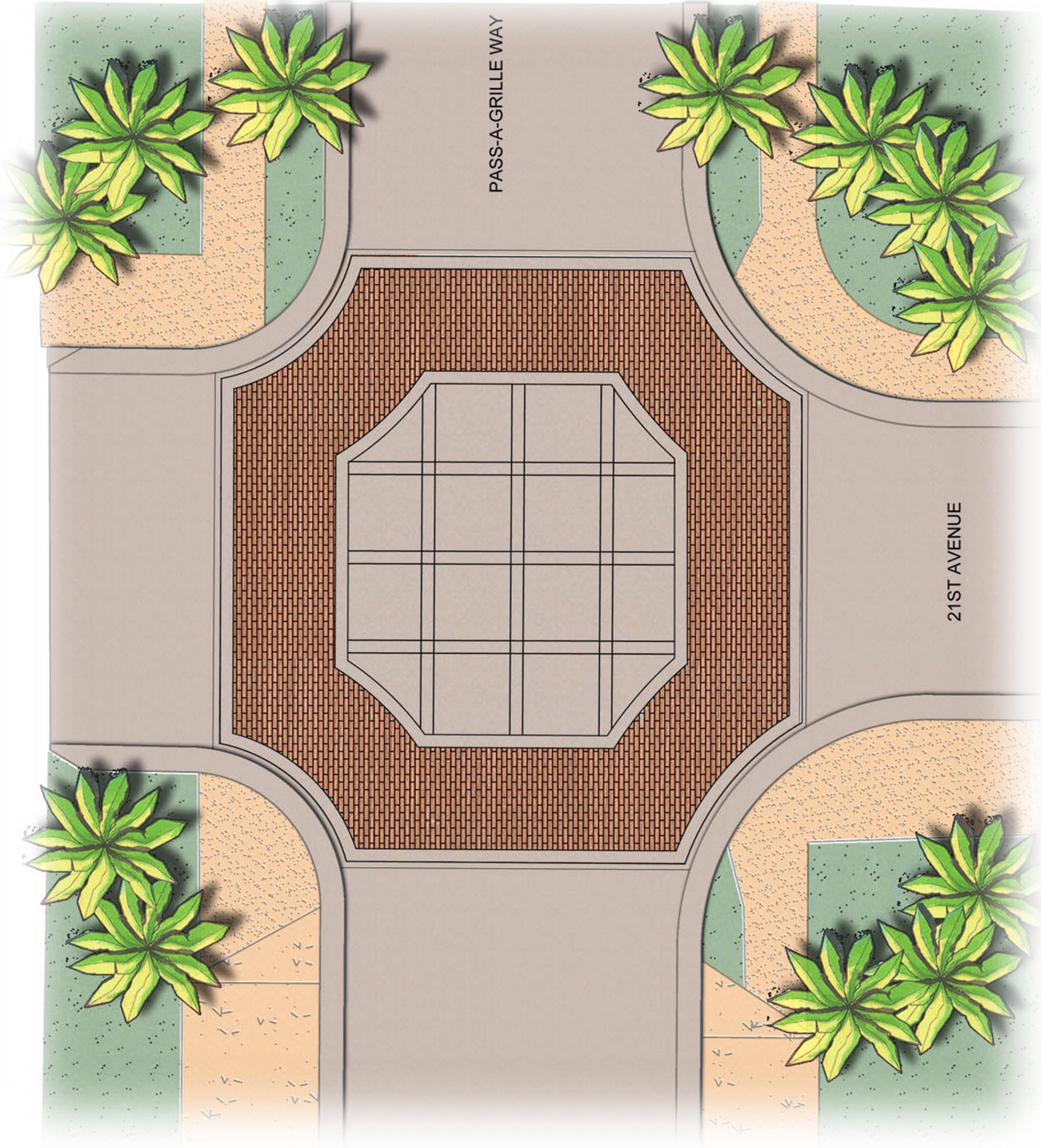
