1. Workshop for Outdoor Drinking and/or Dining

City Manager Wayne Saunders commented that the outdoor drinking and dining concerns are in relation to public property and whether they should be allowed, where they should be allowed, if the allowance should be confined to dining only, etc.

Community Development Director Jennifer Bryla reviewed a PowerPoint Presentation which included the following items:

- Outdoor drinking and/or dining on public/private lands
- Commercial activities
- City's goals and standards set by the community and policy makers
- Community Redevelopment District zoning districts
- Type of service such as ice cream stores, doughnut shops, sandwich shops, non-alcoholic establishments serving food
- Business ingress and egress, hours of operation and proximity to incompatible uses

Commissioner Falkenstein, Commissioner Premier, Commissioner Pletcher and Mayor Lowe were in agreement with fee-based use of parking spaces; Vice Mayor Finnerty was opposed.

Vice Mayor Finnerty and Commissioner Premier were in favor of food and beverage service on the sidewalks; Commissioner Falkenstein, Commissioner Pletcher and Mayor Lowe were opposed.

Vice Mayor Finnerty, Commissioner Falkenstein, Commissioner Premier and Commissioner Pletcher were in favor of incorporating all zoning districts into the proposed ordinance; Mayor Lowe was undecided.

There was a consensus among the Commission to hold an additional workshop to further discuss outdoor drinking and dining at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 28, 2015.

The Commissioners encouraged community members to contact their representatives and voice their preferences and/or concerns.

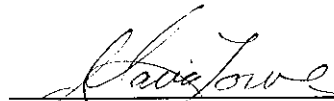
2. Adjournment
